Scriptures are like packets of light that illuminate our minds and give place to guidance and inspiration from on high.

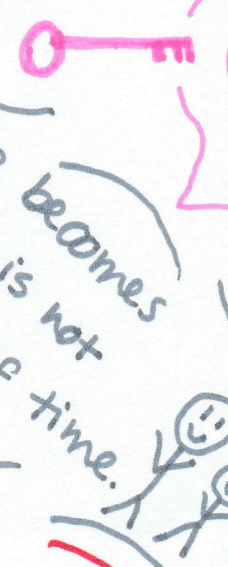
I love the Book of Mormon
